Dear Prime Minister Rasmussen,

I remain deeply grateful for the commitment the international community displayed at the Afghanistan High-Level Strategic Forum on March 17 in Brussels. The level of financial support pledged is greatly appreciated by the Afghan people and will help provide for Afghanistan's needs during the current year.

One critical need that remains to be fully addressed, however, is funding for our Government's operational or ordinary expenses. Specifically, the Government requires an additional US\$ 181 million, if we are to meet our US\$ 550 million budget. Without this, the Government will not be able to provide all services desperately needed by the Afghan people. For instance, we may not be able to pay salaries for teachers and health care workers.

I hope Denmark will be in a position to respond to this request on an urgent basis, as my Finance Minister has indicated that current funds in the Afghanistan Reconstruction Trust Fund, the main source of external funding for our ordinary expenditure, will be depleted soon.

The Afghan people are grateful for the generosity demonstrated by the international community. However, it is also vital that the Government continue its day-to-day operations and increase its capacity to directly improve the lives of the Afghan people. This means ensuring that dependable, uninterrupted financing is available for the central government budget.

I speak for all my countrymen in thanking you for the steadfast support you have shown for Afghanistan as we rebuild our country and lay the foundations for a brighter tomorrow.
